

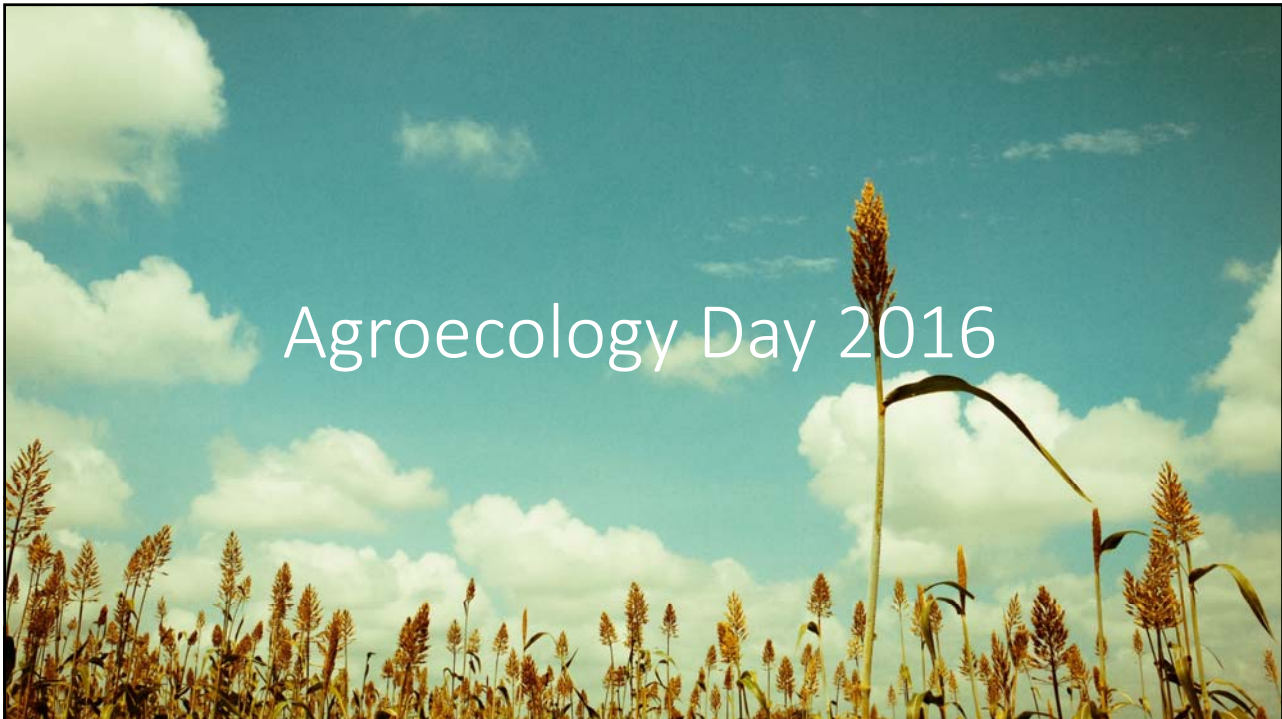

Workshops

Urban Beekeeping (Plantan)

Johan and Terese from Beeurban will give a short introduction to the world of beekeeping. You will prepare a beehive and make it ready for the bees to live while they tell you about the life of the bees living in the hive.

Action Research and Change (106)

Ann and Elina from LUCSUS will hold a workshop on action research focusing on research they have done in Uganda and Kenya. They will address questions touching on how researchers together with local smallholders can contribute to change and what is necessary to make this work.
